- Special thanks to Wes Rubio and Katherine Brisco for coordinating the Bottle Bioassay Workshop for Northern Nevada.
- NDA has received no ELC funding for year 2022. We will keep you posted on test costs for next year.





Staff worked on treating Russian knapweed infestations during the month of October. Staff also worked on winterizing their vehicles and fogger units.

Management worked with Richard Black, Fallon Tribal Environmental Department Head and provided him with a compilation of pesticide labels and prices for all of the pesticides that the District uses and has used to treat mosquito larval source areas and adult mosquito populations that were on Tribal ground. This was done so that they could plan and possibly purchase pesticides to treat such source areas and adult mosquito problems in the future seasons.

Administrative Assistant, Melania Sagi put together a Uniform Equipment Issuance and Agreement document that staff will need to sign off on when they return from the temporary layoff. Our last uniform company charged the District for uniforms that were not returned by staff. This amounted to approximately \$800. This is a significant amount of money that we do not want to have a repeat scenario to pay out in the future. See attached document. This would also apply to the laptop computers that the District Manager and Administrative Assistant carry.

District Legal Counsel, Ben Shawcroft drafted policy language for entering on private property in order to perform mosquito surveillance and abatement. This came up when an employee expressed frustration over finding stagnant water and a mosquito breeding problem in what appeared to be an abandoned or empty residence. This was a concern in that what may appear to be abandoned or empty may not be and rather than to have staff appear to be entering private property and looking around may be a situation in which their safety is jeopardized. See the attached document regarding "Entering Private Property". Whereas, we do not have any policy language addressing this currently or have had in the past, this may be something that we want to train the staff and have them sign off as understanding the potential legalities of such when they return.

Finally, Management and Trustee Jonte attended a training on October 26-27, 2021 regarding pesticide resistance and bioassay resistance testing of pesticides. This was an elaborate training which will be explained in greater detail at the meeting but will definitely be utilized in the upcoming season so as to make sure that our operations are not furthering the potential of developing mosquito resistant populations by using the same pesticides over and over again at the same locations. Whereas this has always been recommended to alternate treatments of pesticides during the season, this training made it possible to verify whether we have such a problem in the valley. The CDC is currently provided equipment necessary to perform this testing free of charge to Districts willing to complete the lab work. This lab work will also be uploaded to a State system which makes the information available and/or transparent to other pesticide companies and County Abatement District's. If you have any questions regarding this, please let me know.

POLICY

Entering Private Property

The following represents the policy of the District concerning the entrance by employees onto private property for weed or mosquito abatement work. District employees may only enter private property in a manner consistent with the U.S. Constitution, Nevada law, and this policy.

1. Open Fields vs. Private Areas

- a. "Open fields" are defined as those areas that are unoccupied or undeveloped outside of the private areas of a structure. Examples include open and generally accessible fields, pastures, agricultural land, drains and ditches, and open space to which there isn't a clear intent by the owner to keep the public out. It also includes unfenced front yards, common areas of an apartment complex, vacant or abandoned property.
- b. "Private Areas" are defined as any dwellings and the area immediately surrounding them. Examples include property that is enclosed by a privacy fence, the general exterior of the dwelling not including the front approach to the home, fenced areas where the owner has exhibited an expectation of privacy through no trespassing signs or locked gates.

2. Service Requests

- a. Technicians acting on a service request shall contact the requesting party prior to entering the property to receive consent to do so.
- b. If the technician is unable to contact the requesting party, he/she may only enter those areas of the property that are considered "open fields". No attempt shall be made to enter Private Areas without first receiving consent from the owner/occupant.

3. Open Observation

- a. Technicians who need to treat an area which is not the subject of a service request shall first make an attempt to contact and receive consent from the owner/occupant prior to making entry.
- b. If the technician is unable to contact the owner/occupant, the technician many enter any areas that are Open Fields to perform work but shall take extra precaution not to enter any areas that may be considered Private Areas. When in doubt, technicians should err on the side of it being a Private Area and continue to make attempts to contact the owner/occupant prior to making entry.
